Concept:

Mumps is a **viral infection** that primarily affects **saliva-producing (salivary) glands** that are located near your ears. Mumps can cause swelling in one or both of these glands. Some people experience no symptoms. When symptoms occur, they include **swollen, painful salivary glands, fever, headache, fatigue** and **appetite loss** . Treatment focuses on symptom relief. Recovery takes about two weeks. The disease can be prevented by the MMR vaccine.
