Concept:**Transparent Objects**

If you are able to see **clearly through an object**, it is allowing light to pass through it and is **transparent** . For example :water,clear glass etc.

Opaque Objects

If we **cannot see through** an object at all, it is an **opaque** object. For example: wooden door, wall etc.

Translucent Objects

There are some objects **through which we can see, but not very clearly** . Such objects are known as **translucent** . For example: Butter paper, ground glass etc
